# Happy Little Bird

Colors Used On The Bird: Banding Blue + Flag Blue, and Black.

Mix a little bit of Flux into the Blue colors. This will help the blues mature/shine at a lower temperature fire.

Background colors: Shading Green and Banding Blue.

A wash of Light Yellow Brown in the background on the Third Fire.

Be sure to wipe out all highlights on each fire.

Pine Needles: Antique Green, Shading Green.

Pine Cones: Medium Brown, Dark Brown.

Scrolls: Antique Green, and a little Dark Brown.

First Fire cone .016.

Second Fire cone .017.

Third Fire cone .018.

**Wolf Ornament** 

Colors used: Light Yellow Brown, Yellow Brown #2, Dark Brown, and Black.

First Fire:

Fur: Lay in the Black.

Nose: Use Dark Brown under the Black. Wipe out highlights.

Fire to cone .017.

Second Fire: Reinforce the darks. Add Light Yellow Brown, and Yellow Brown #2. Wipe out highlights. Fire to cone .018.



## **Bear Coaster**

Palette of Colors:

Light Yellow Brown: highlights

on fur, ears

Yellow Brown #2: eyes, some

edges of fur.

Banding Blue: nose

Rich Brown: side of nose and

eyes

Dark Brown: ears

Dark Brown + Black: fur

Black and a touch of Banding

Blue: fur, nose

Pompadour: inside mouth, very

light

### First Fire:

Lay in the colors as they are in the first fire painting. Brush strokes the way the fur grows.

Smooth the paint and wipe out all highlights. I like to add just a touch of blue or brown to my black to give it life. Fire to cone .016.

### Second and Third Fires:

Add colors to increase depth.

Wipe out highlights.

Second Fire cone .017.

Third Fire .018.
