Maya K. Fares presents" How to paint "Black, White and Gold pearls on Porcelain"

My demo is about how to paint pearls, white, black and Gold one.

I have learned this technique from the Artist Peter Faust but i have made some experiments and i came up with new technique.

Follow my instructions to know how.

You need:

Closed medium MX54 or Copaïva

Turpentine

Mother of pearl Lustre

Colours Grey Pink Black Purple and Green

Matt white

- 1- draw your pearls on the porcelain support with Grey colour mixed with a pen oil medium and let it dry.
- 2- paint the whole white pearls with mother of pearl lustre. Let it dry then fire it 780°C
- 3- Mix colours with MX54 or Copaïva
- 4- start painting the pearls with grey and pink colour, use stipler to soften the color, taking care of the shadows and highlights .
- 5- make the shadow of the pearls. Fire it 780°C
- 6- make a wash with grey and a small black line with a liner

Gold Pearl

- 1- Draw the pearls with Grey colour
- 2- put Gold colour let it dry and fire it 780°C
- 3- paint the pearls with black
- 4- add shadow with grey colour, use stipler to soften the colour. Fire it 780°C

Black Pearl

- 1- Draw the pearls with grey colour
- 2- mix black and purple colour and paint the pearls.
- 3- make the highlights
- 4- add some green in the highlight and use stipler for smoothing colours
- 5- add the shadow with Grey. Fire at 780°C
- 6- add again Black if needed
- 7- with a liner intense the outline of the pearl especially in the darkest side. Fire 780°C

The plate is 17.5 cm
